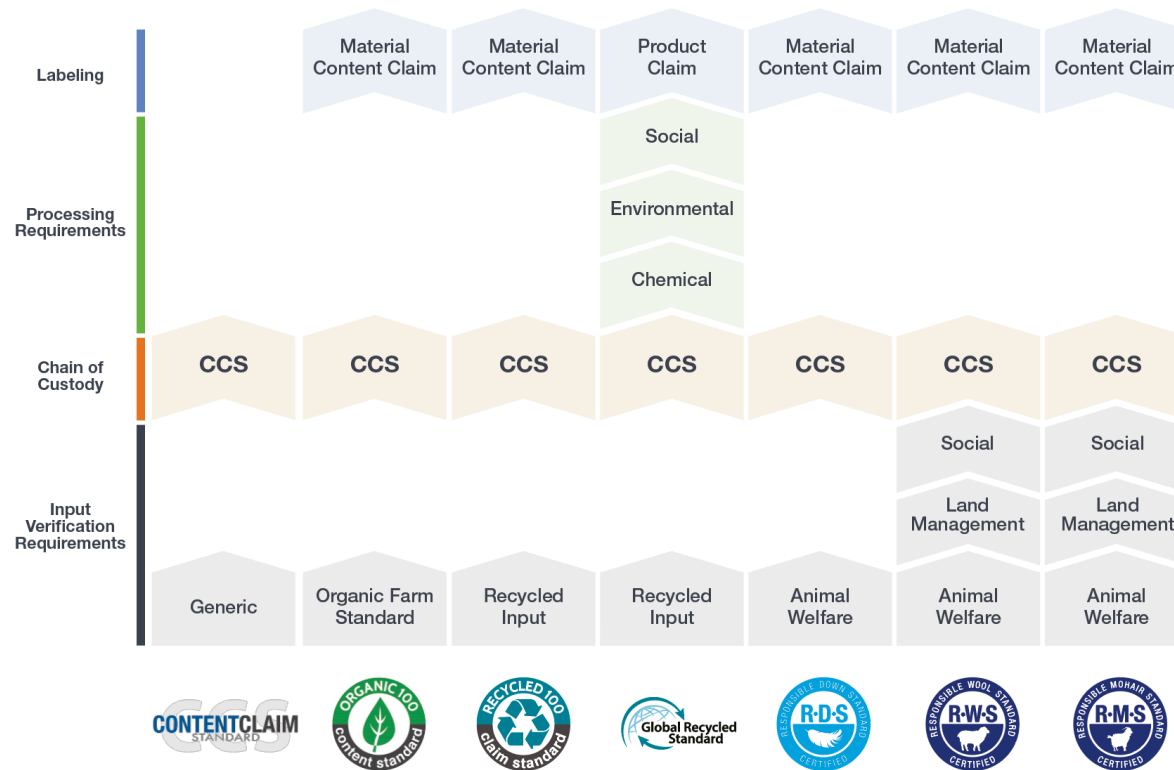

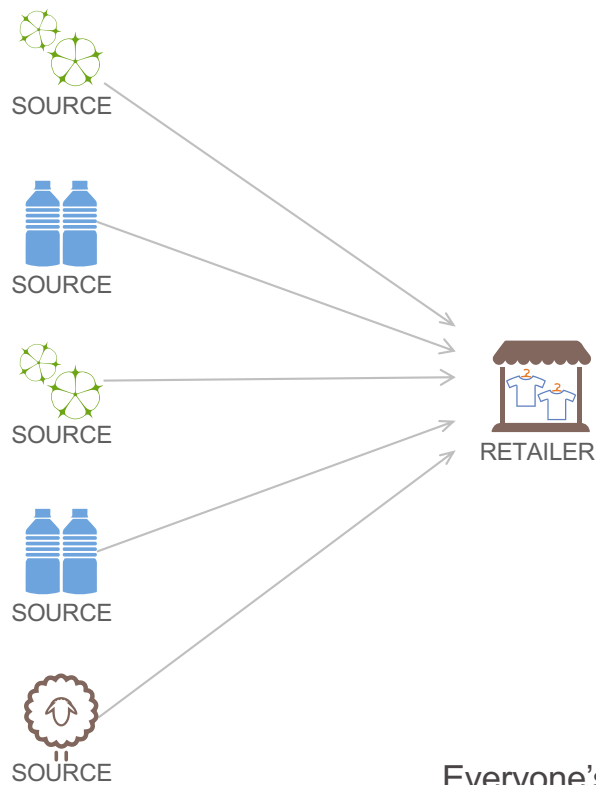

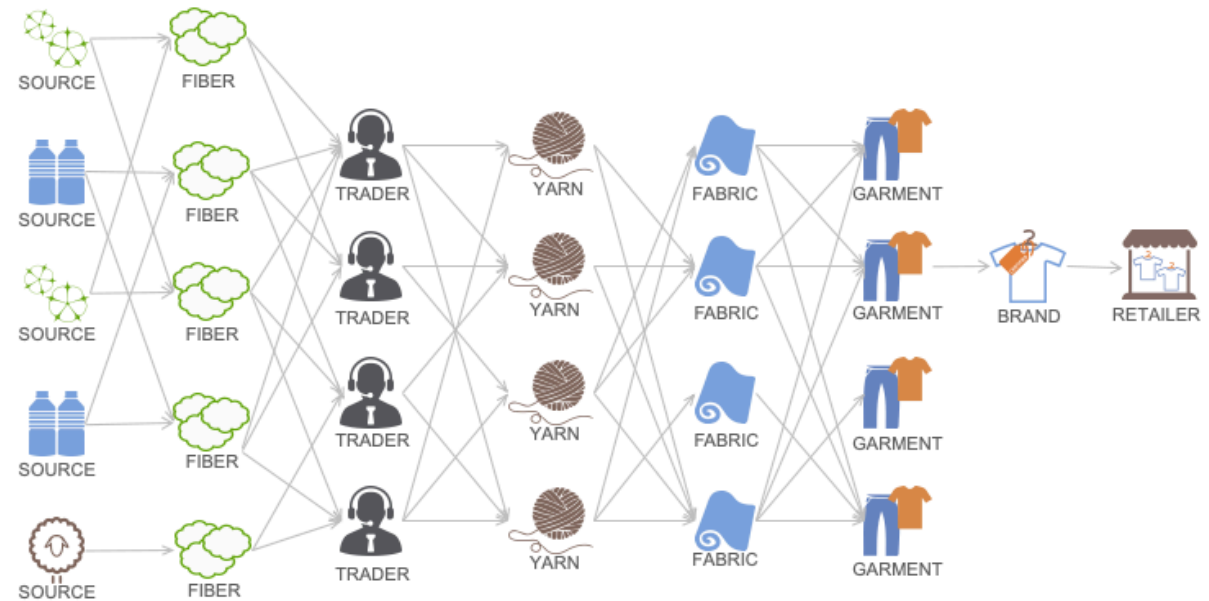

The Challenge: Managing Supply Chain Complexity



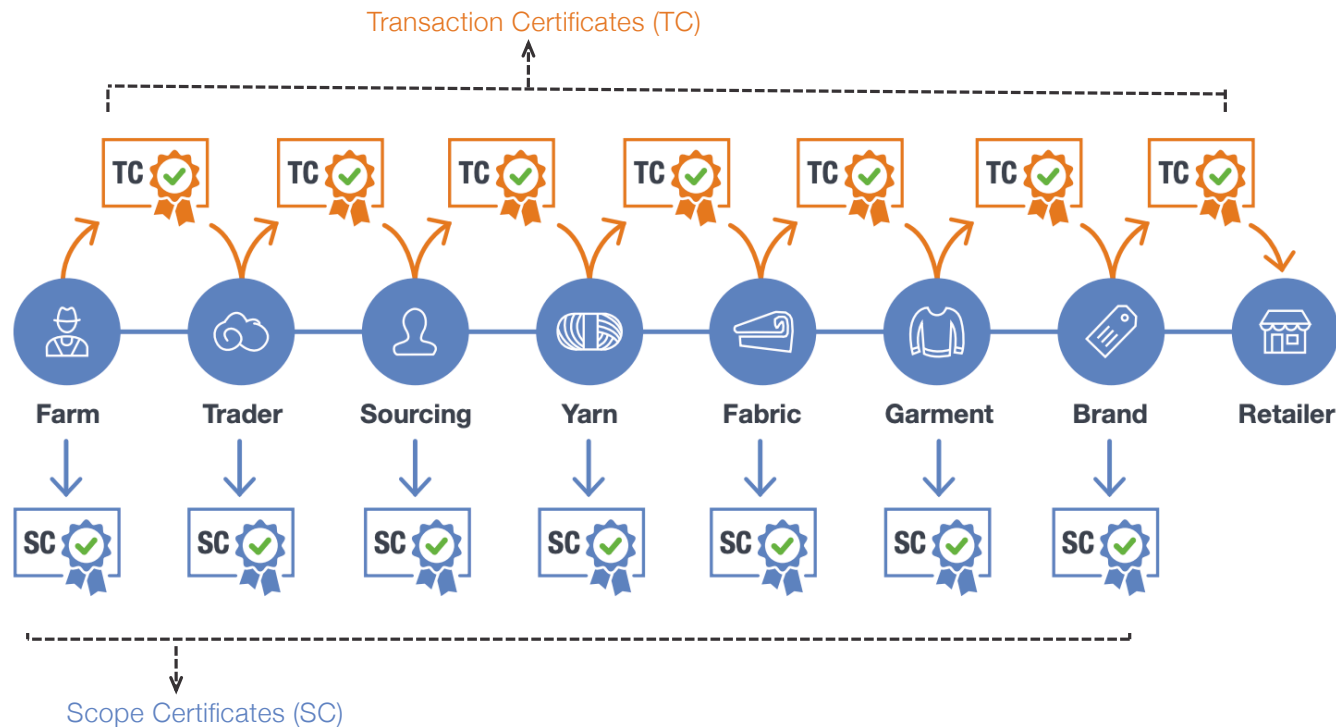

The Solution: Principles of Chain of Custody

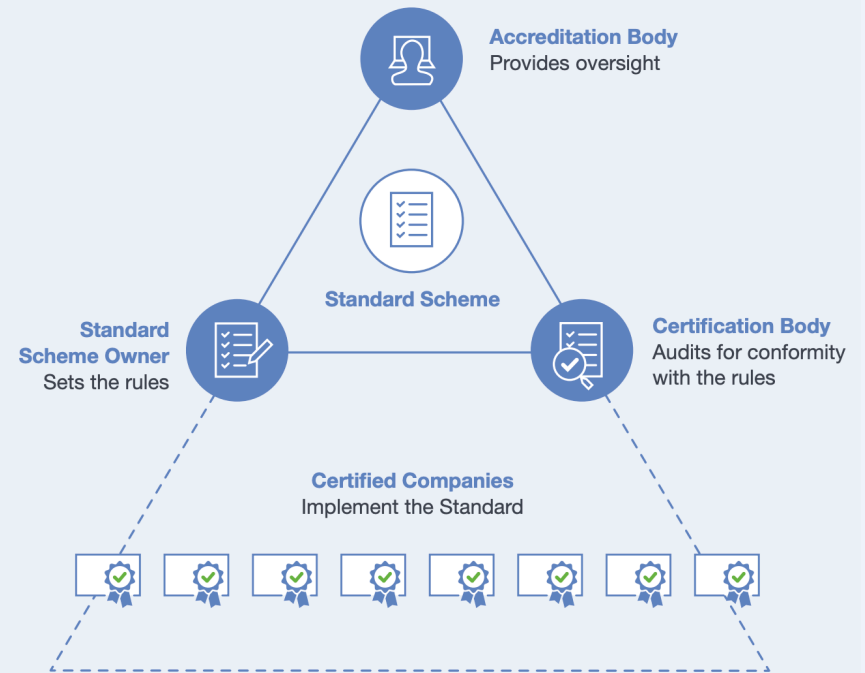
The aim of chain of custody, is to preserve the identity of the claimed material, and to track its movement through the supply chain up to the final product. This is done through 1 Scope Certificates (SC) and 2 Transaction Certificates (TC)

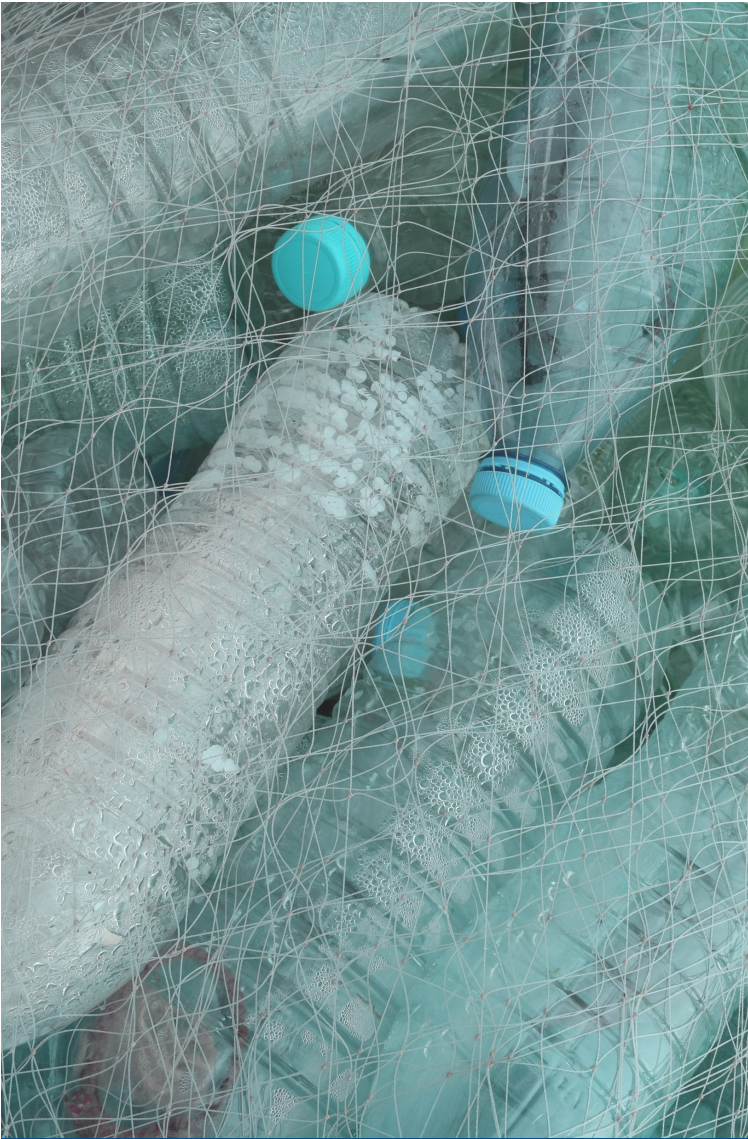


The forward product path is ensured, but suppliers are able to preserve confidentiality if desired.

Roles of Organizations

- **Textile Exchange (scheme owner):** sets the rules
- **Certification body (CB):** audits for conformity with the rules set by scheme owner
- **Accreditation body (AB):** provides oversight over the CBs and the scheme owner
- **Certified companies (you!):** implement the standard according the rules and the audit processes





Goal of Recycled Claim Standard and Global Recycled Standard

Increase the use of recycled materials in products.

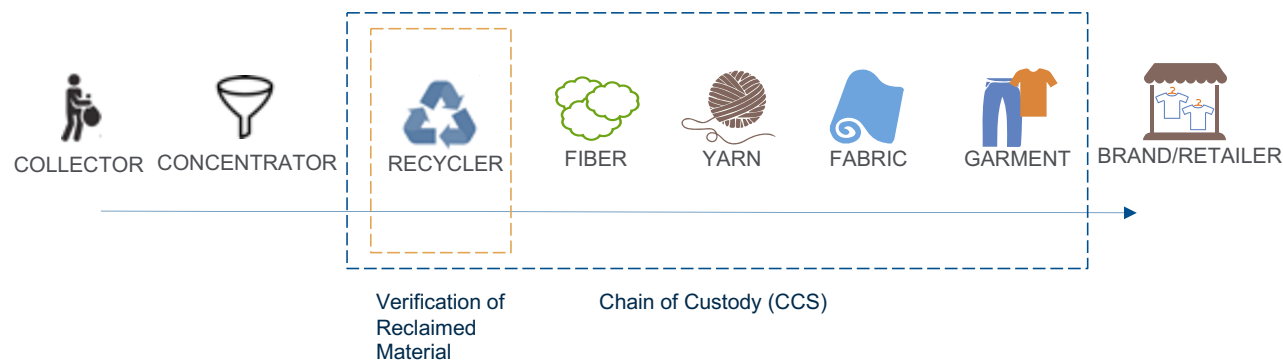
Increase the use of recycled materials in products

Reduce/eliminate the harm caused by its production.

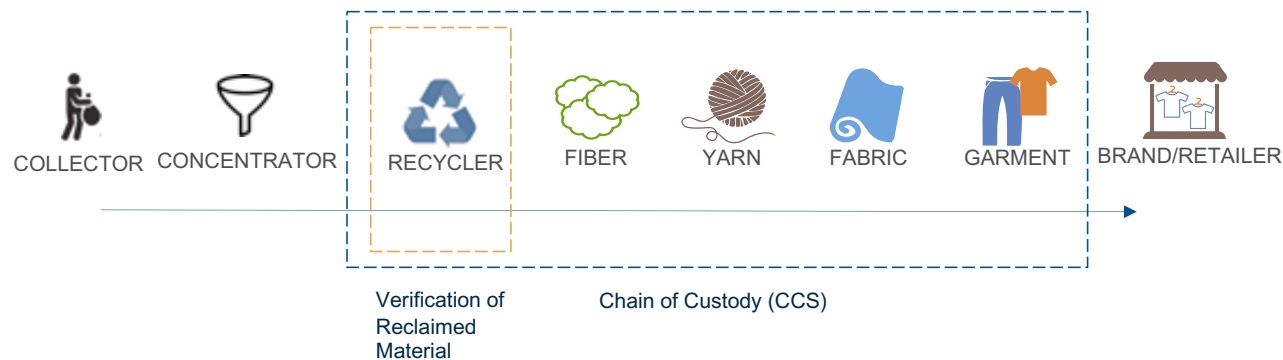


Scope of the Recycled Claim Standard (RCS)



- Ensures raw material meets definition of recycled (ISO 14021).
- Chain of custody from source to final product
- 100% or blended products (**5-95% recycled content**).
- Does **NOT** cover:
 - Processing criteria

Scope of the Global Recycled Standard (GRS)



- Ensures raw material meets definition of recycled (ISO 14021).
- Applies to products with 20% or more recycled content.
- Consumer communication for **50% or more recycled content**
- Chain of custody from source to final product
- Includes social and environmental requirements
- Restricts intentional use of hazardous chemicals in GRS products.

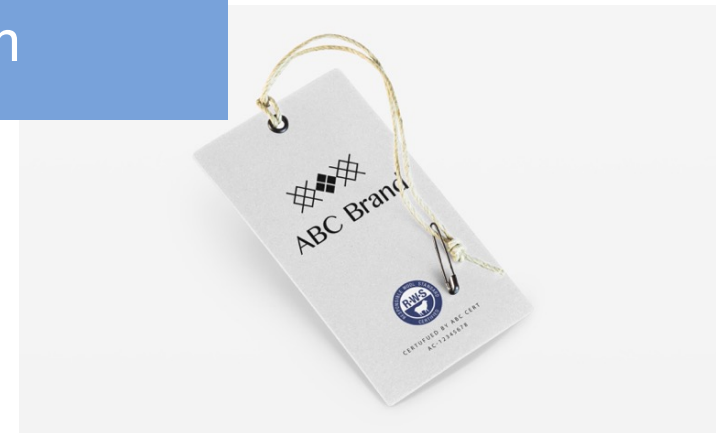


There are two types of claims that are used to communicate about a standard.

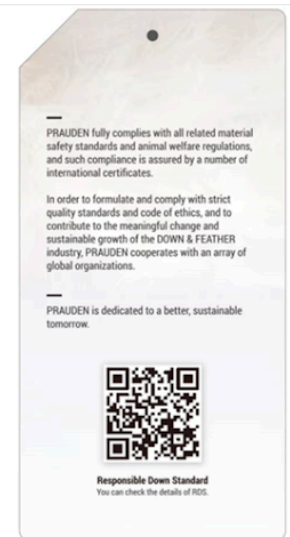
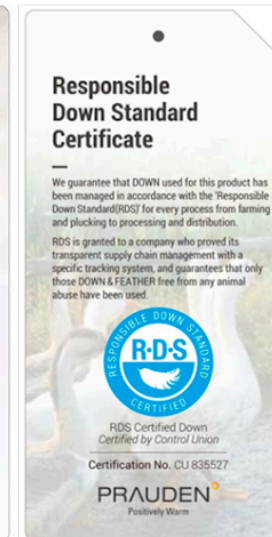
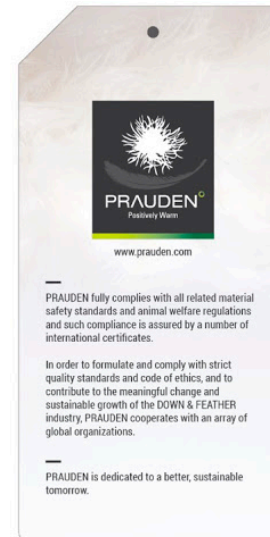
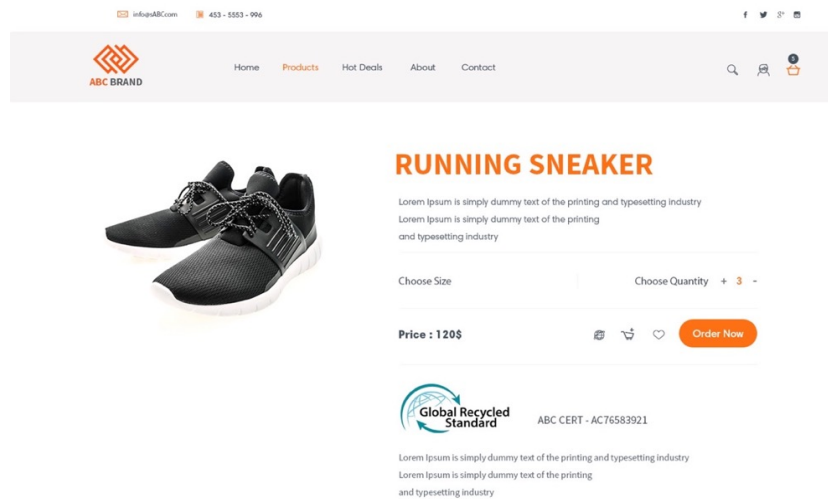


General Marketing Claims

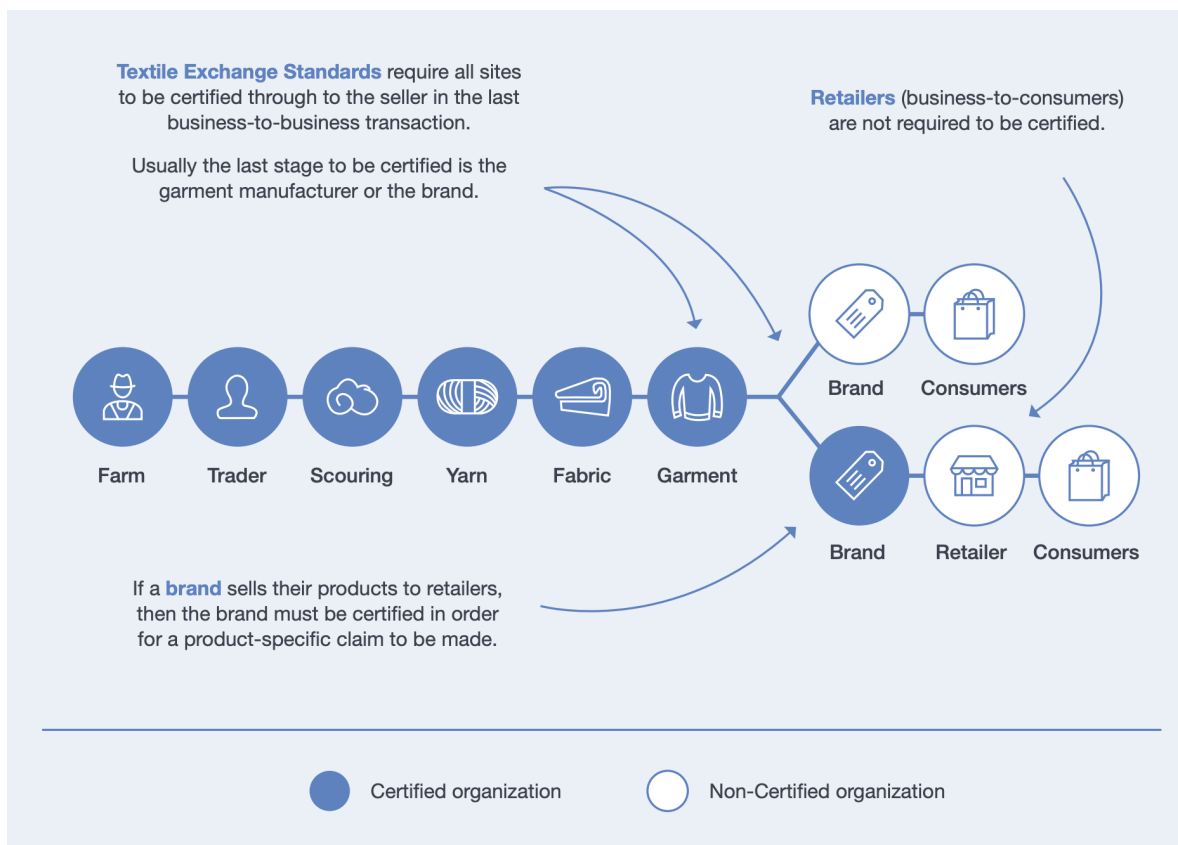
When a company refers to standards without mentioning a specific product or product category, these are called general marketing claims.

- *“We are committed to sourcing only GRS certified materials by 2025”*
 - *“All of ABC Brand’s down duvet covers will be RDS certified by 2020”*
 - *“The Responsible Wool Standard addresses the welfare of sheep and the land they graze on.”*

Product-Specific Claim Examples



What do I need to do if I want to label?



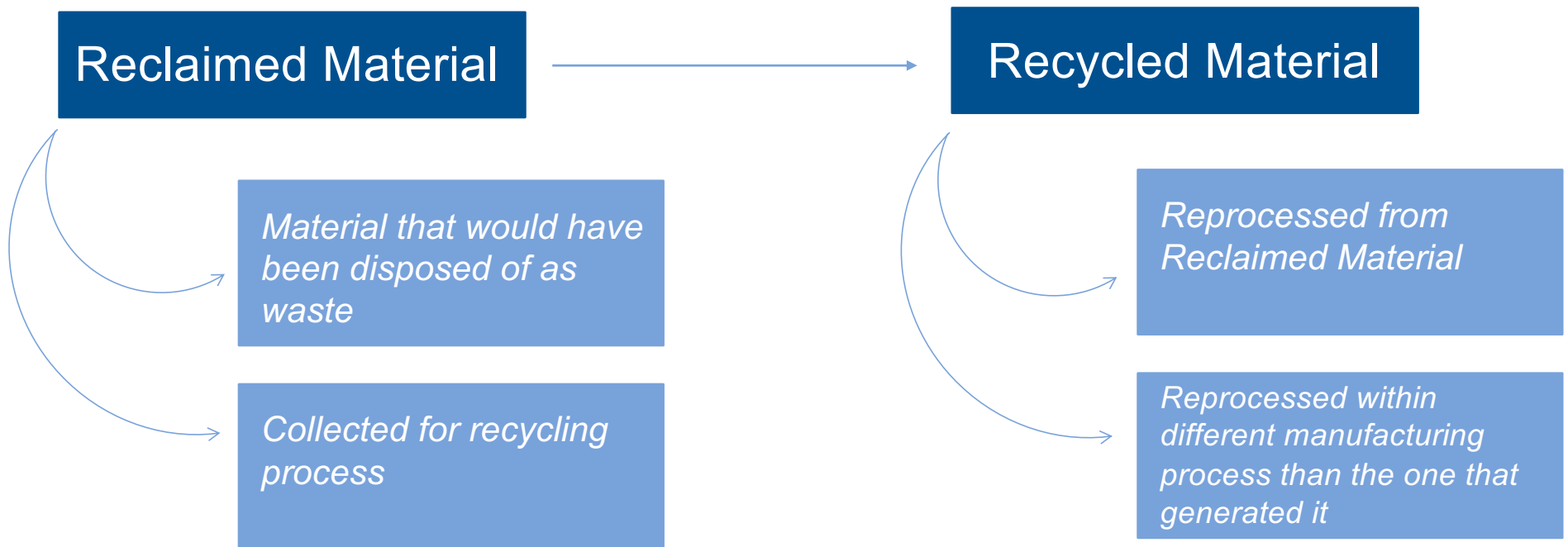
- ✓ Proof of a certified supply chain up to last the B2B transaction
- ✓ Comply with our Logo Use and Claims Guide/ Claims Policy
- ✓ Receive approval from a certification body (CB)

Can components be labelled under GRS/RCS?



- Components may be labelled, as long as the full supply chain is certified.
- Percentages may be calculated by volume or weight, trims and accessories may be excluded.

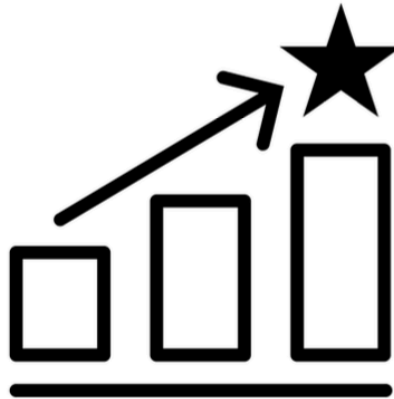
Made from recycled polyester

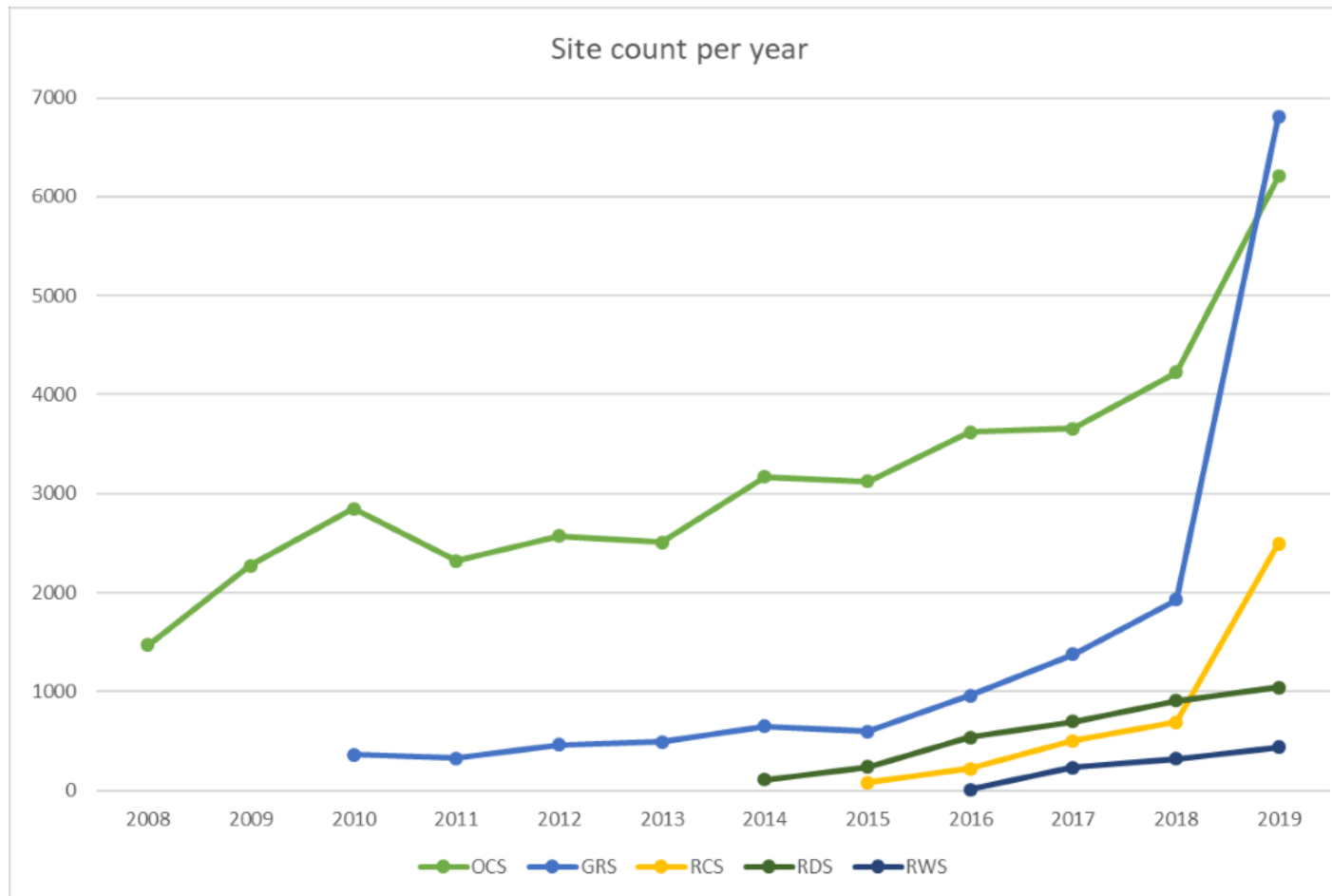

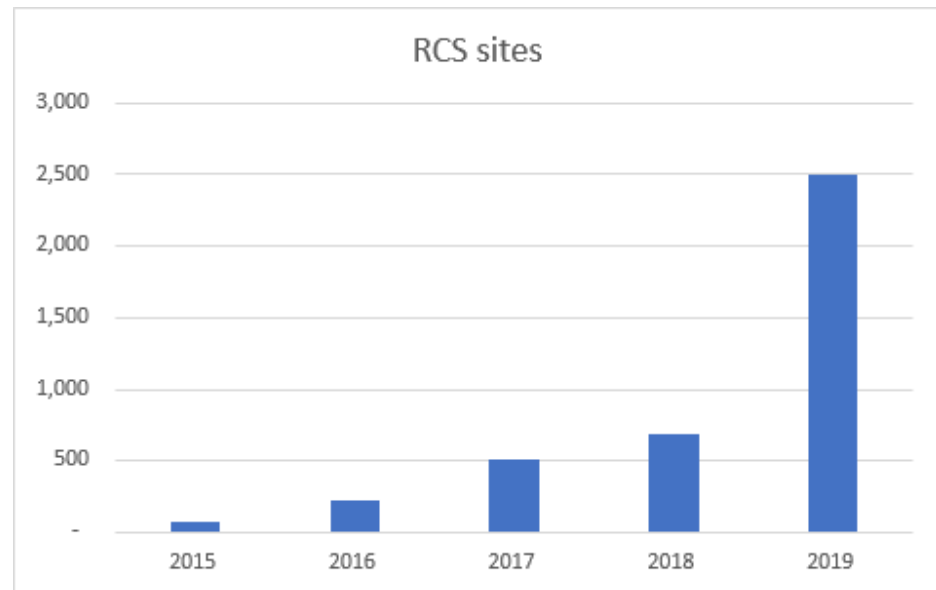
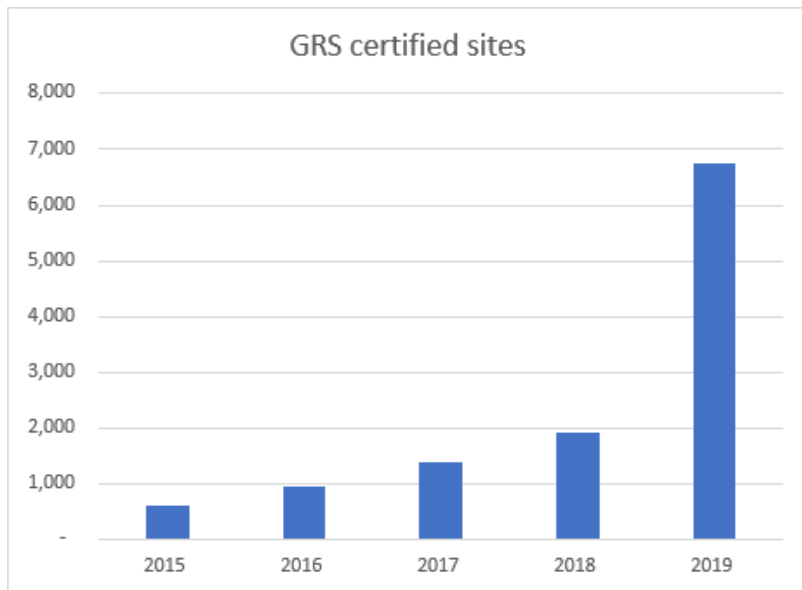

2019 GRS and RCS by the Numbers

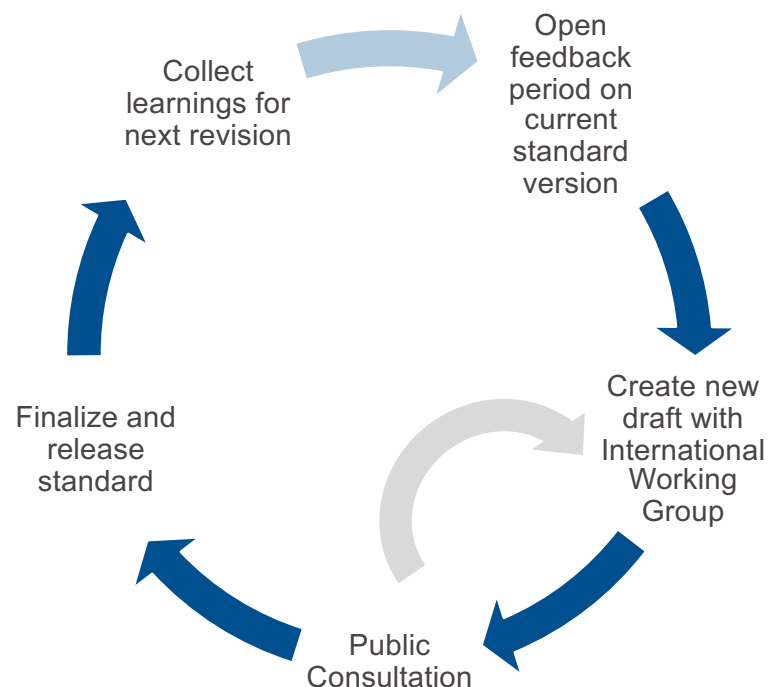


Textile Exchange's Climate+ Strategy

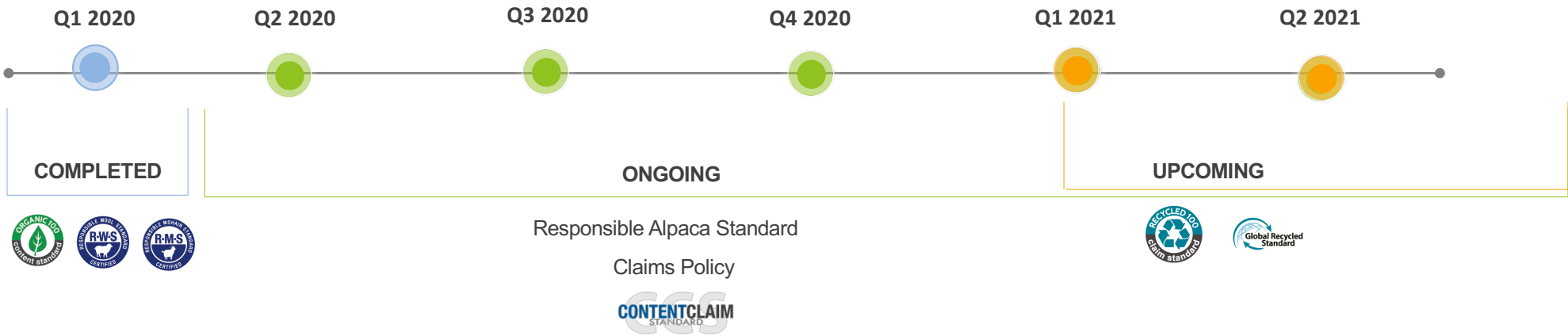
Upcoming GRS / RCS Revision



Examples of topics to tackle:

- Adding a climate lens to the GRS/RCS
- Clearer definition of feedstocks (e.g. ocean/ocean-bound plastic)
- Include feedstock info on the TC
- More specificity about chemical recycling

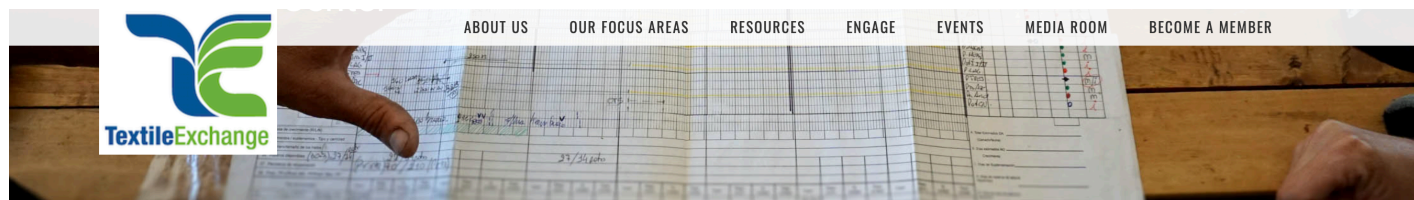
