See cutting-edge textile sorting in action in this guided tour of Portugal's first automated waste sorting line. Hear about the latest sorting innovations, take part in interactive workshops comparing human and machine identification, and meet the teams who created and work with this groundbreaking technology before watching it in operation.

What you'll experience:

- An overview of current innovations in textile sorting with leading European tech company PICVISA, which
 installed the sorting line. This will include the latest on shape recognition, knotted versus woven
 identification, and advances in shoe and reuse sorting.
- A hands-on workshop comparing human and machine-based identification of textile types using the ECOSORT system's near-infrared (NIR) technology. This interactive activity will highlight the real-world challenges and value of automation in textile recycling.
- A live demonstration of the automated sorting line in action, with a tour of Lipor's facilities.
